



# Circle Cone Pocket note

Use the following pocket note to help guide the Children in making their own circle cones – look at the type of uses a cone may have and what the Children have experience of.

Use with collage materials – mathematical and numerical tools for mark making and measurement.

Send out as part of your home communications – display board notifications and activity events. Use to look at diameter – what measuring implications there may be for big and small – too big and too small.

Cut pocket note and laminate for longer use.

## Circle Cones and finding a circle's centre

Mark out your circle using a preferred or to hand method:

Compass and ruler – Number line or other

Bowl, cup or template to draw around ..

### GUIDE:

Draw circular outline - Cut and fold in half – fold again into quarter and mark the tip..

Open out and cut from the outer edge into the centre mark.

curl around to form the cone shape.

Tape edge in place and use as wished ..
