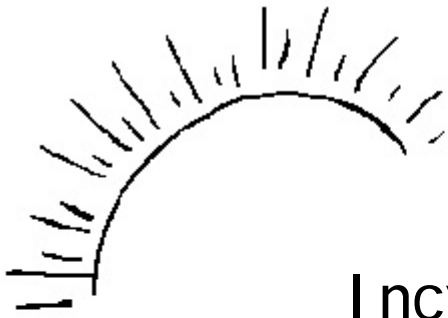

We have developed a role play scenario set for you to print and make with your children. Step by step instructions are given and the photo demonstrates what the set will look like once finished!

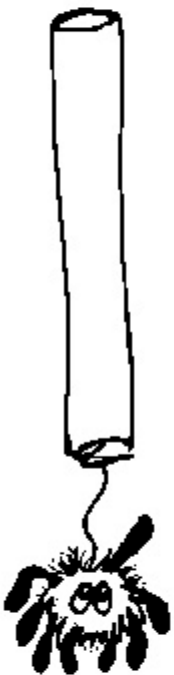
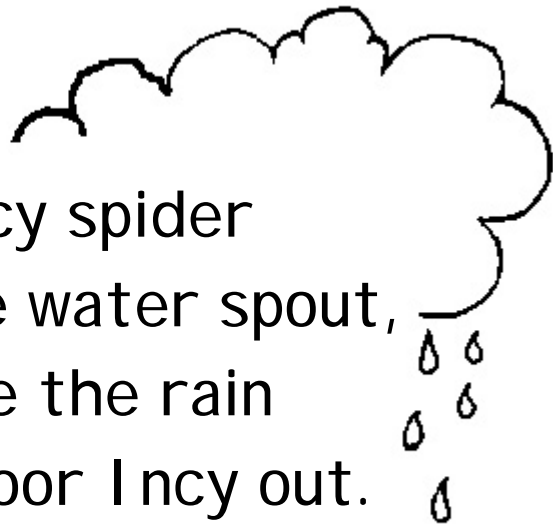

Incy Wincy Spider



Incy Wincy spider

Instructions

Use the picture above as a guide to the set's assembly.






The Background

-  Use 3 sheets of A4 light Blue card.
-  Print out the Sun and glue it to one of the background sheets.
-  Glue some strips of green paper along the bottom edges – to resemble grass.
-  ONCE the rain cloud sheet has been completed.....
-  Tape the long edges of the sheets together.




Water Spout

-  Print out the spout picture.
-  Cut out, laminate, then cut out again.
-  Roll up into a tube and secure the edges together with tape.
-  Glue the back of the tube to the middle of a background sheet.




The Sunshine

-  The Sunshine hides behind a 'flap'
-  Cut this from a separate piece of matching blue paper.
-  Laminate the flap.
-  Fold a 1cm tab at the top. Use a rolling pin to strengthen the crease.
-  Glue the tab to the top of the blue background. So that the sunshine is hidden and can the appear to 'Dry up all the rain!'.

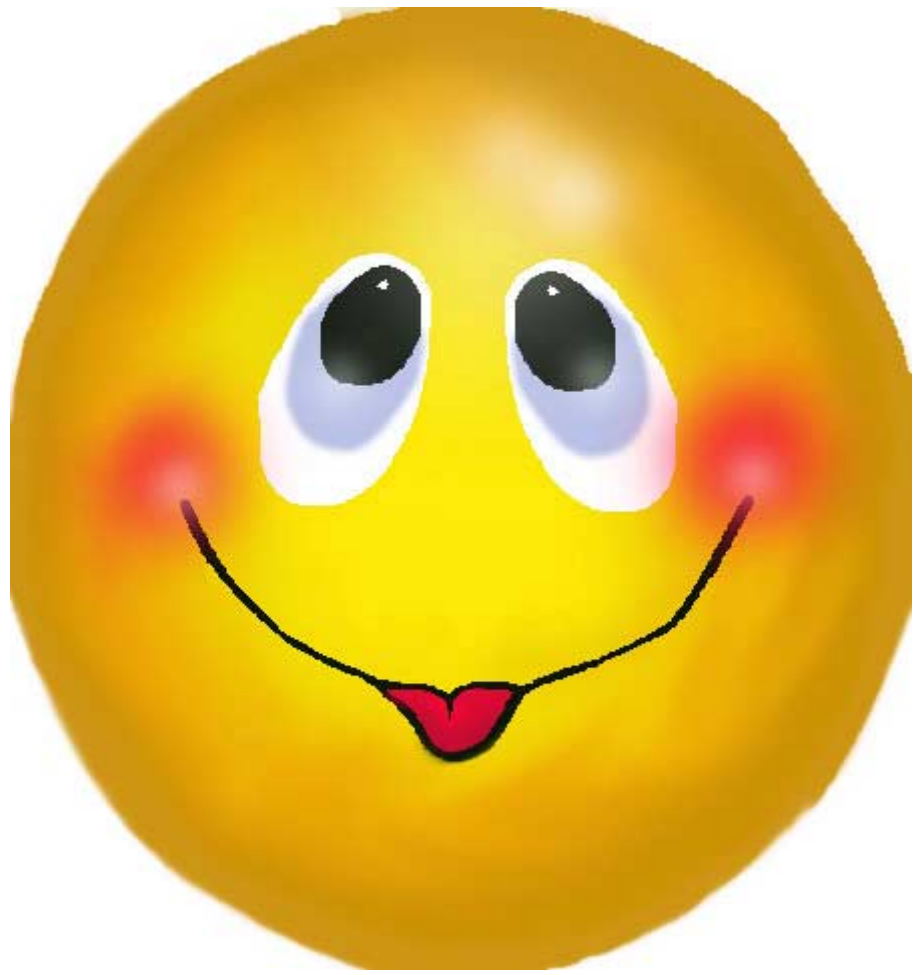
DAISYS

-  Cut out as many daisy flowers as you wish glue a circle of gold foil into the middle of each and laminate.
-  Cut out again and gently bend up the petals.
-  Once the background has been completed glue the daisy centre backs on to the sheets, where ever you want.

Incy Wincy Spider Puppet.

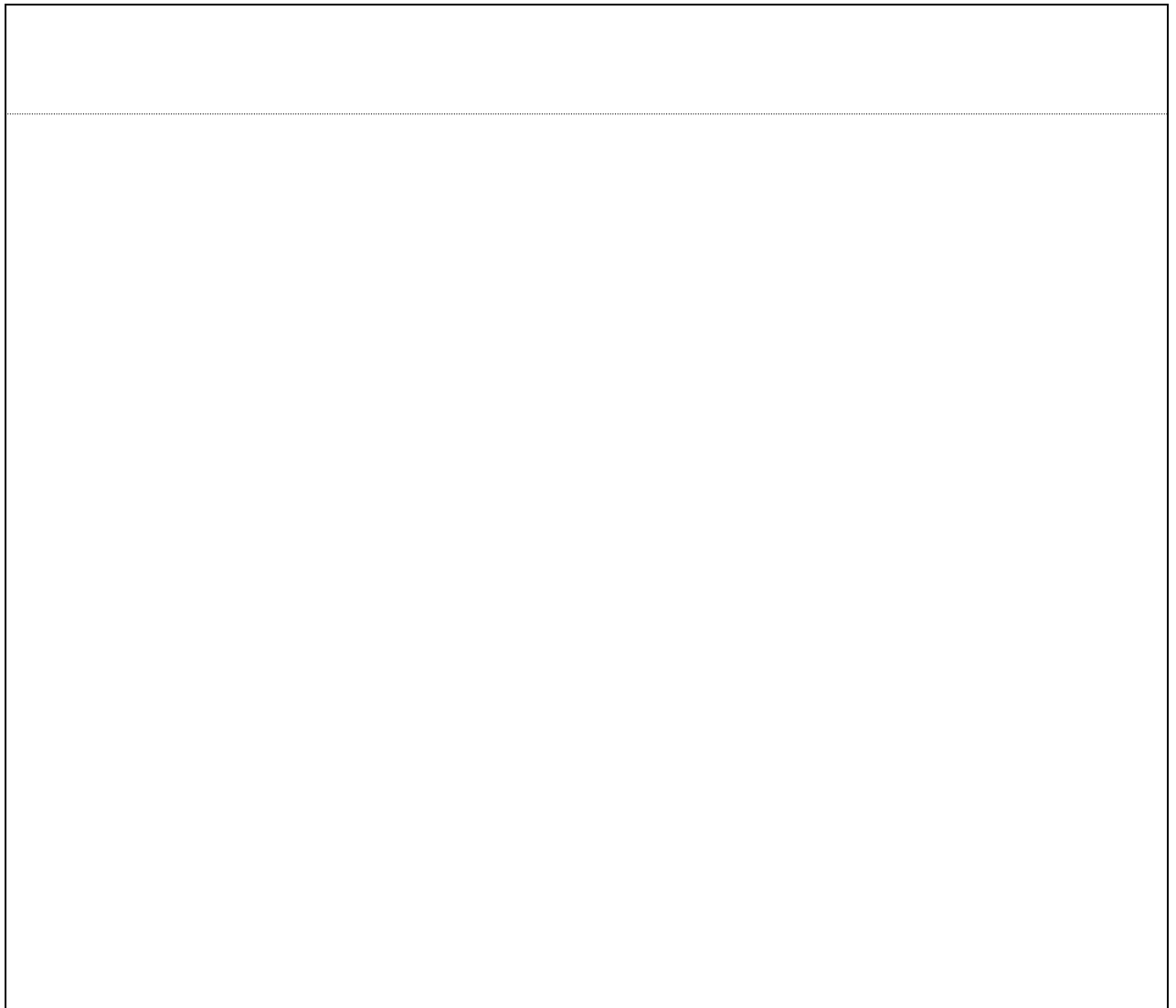
-  Print and cut out.
-  Laminate and cut out again.
-  Glue to the end of a lolly/popsicle stick

Sun Flap use as
a template -
cut from

Tab - cut, Laminate,

Spout



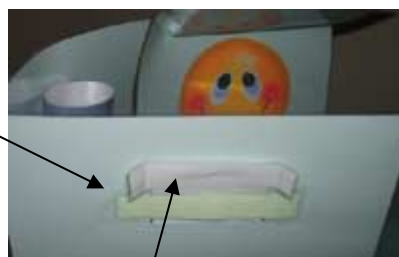
The Daisy template



Rain Cloud instructions

The rain drops are a 'Pull tab' type of illustration - so that the children can simulate the 'Down came the rain' part of the nursery rhyme.

- ✿ Print out a rain cloud - sheet of rain drops and 'raindrop guide'
- ✿ Cut them all out
- ✿ Glue the cloud to one of the A4 blue backgrounds.
- ✿ Laminate the sheet.
- ✿ With a sharp knife cut the black line in the cloud - this is where the raindrops will come through.
- ✿ Laminate both the Rain and the rain guide - cut out again.
- ✿ On the back of the A4 background tape each end of the rain guide just above the cut line.

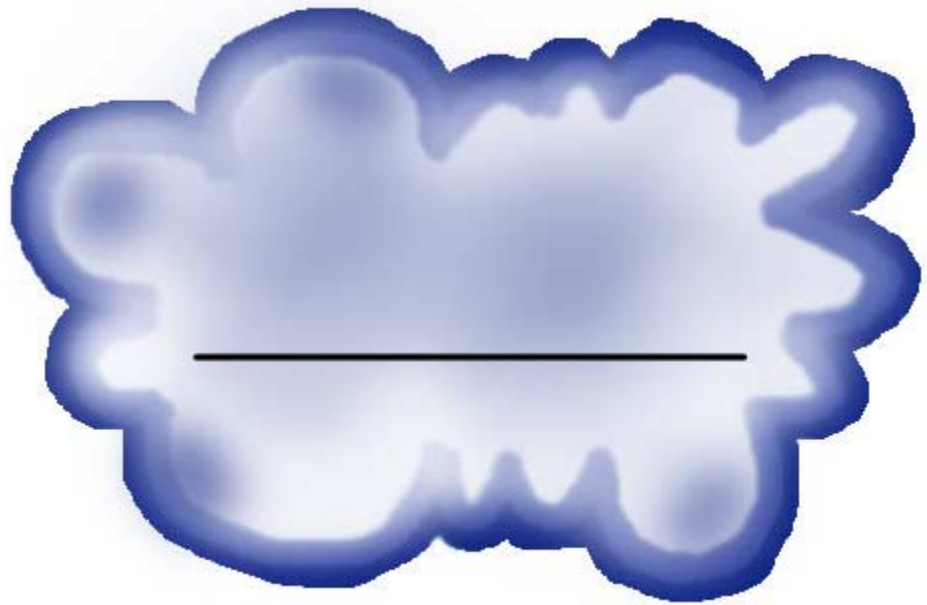


- ✿ Slide the rain in through the cut and fold back the ends a bit so the children can pull the rain up and down.

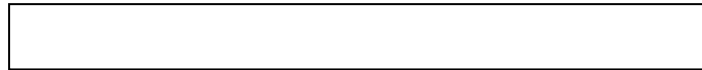
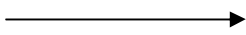
