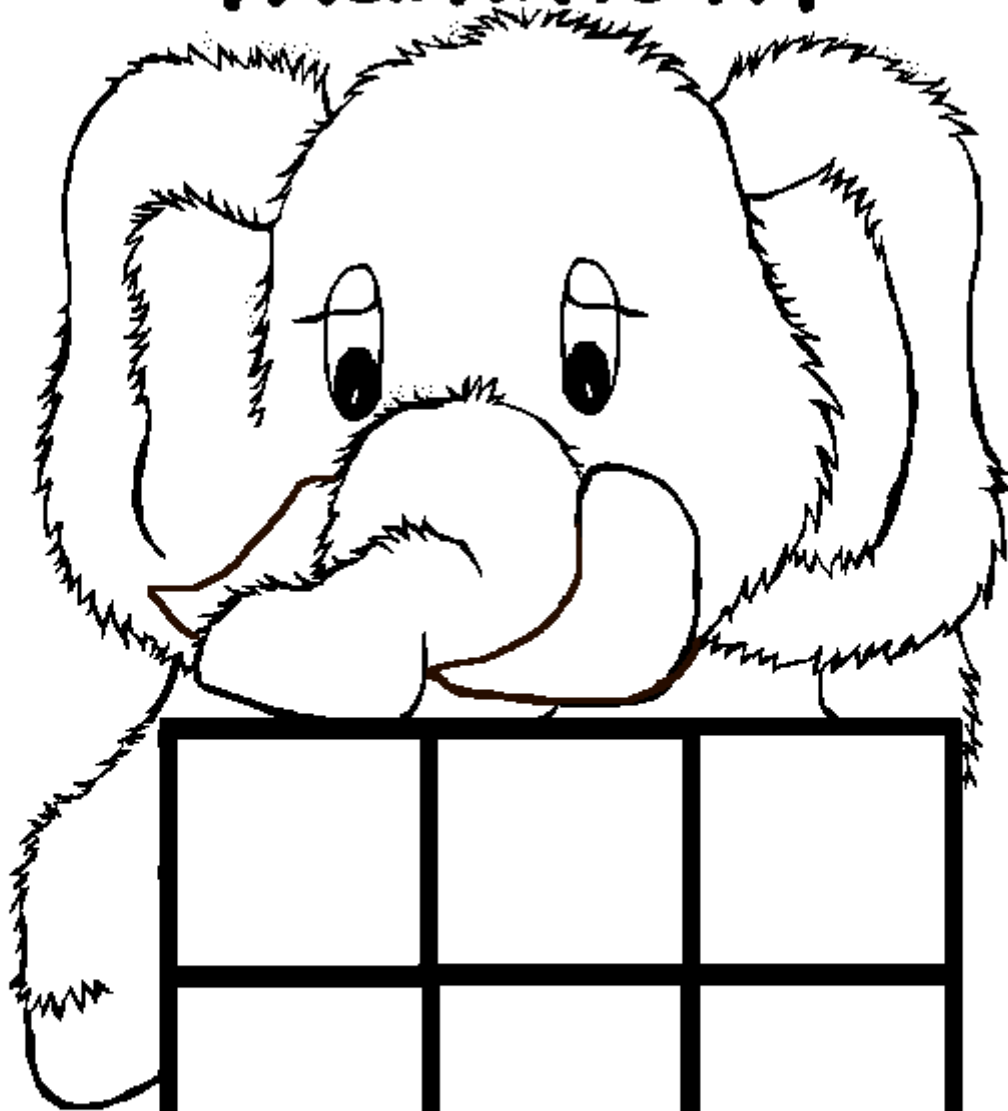

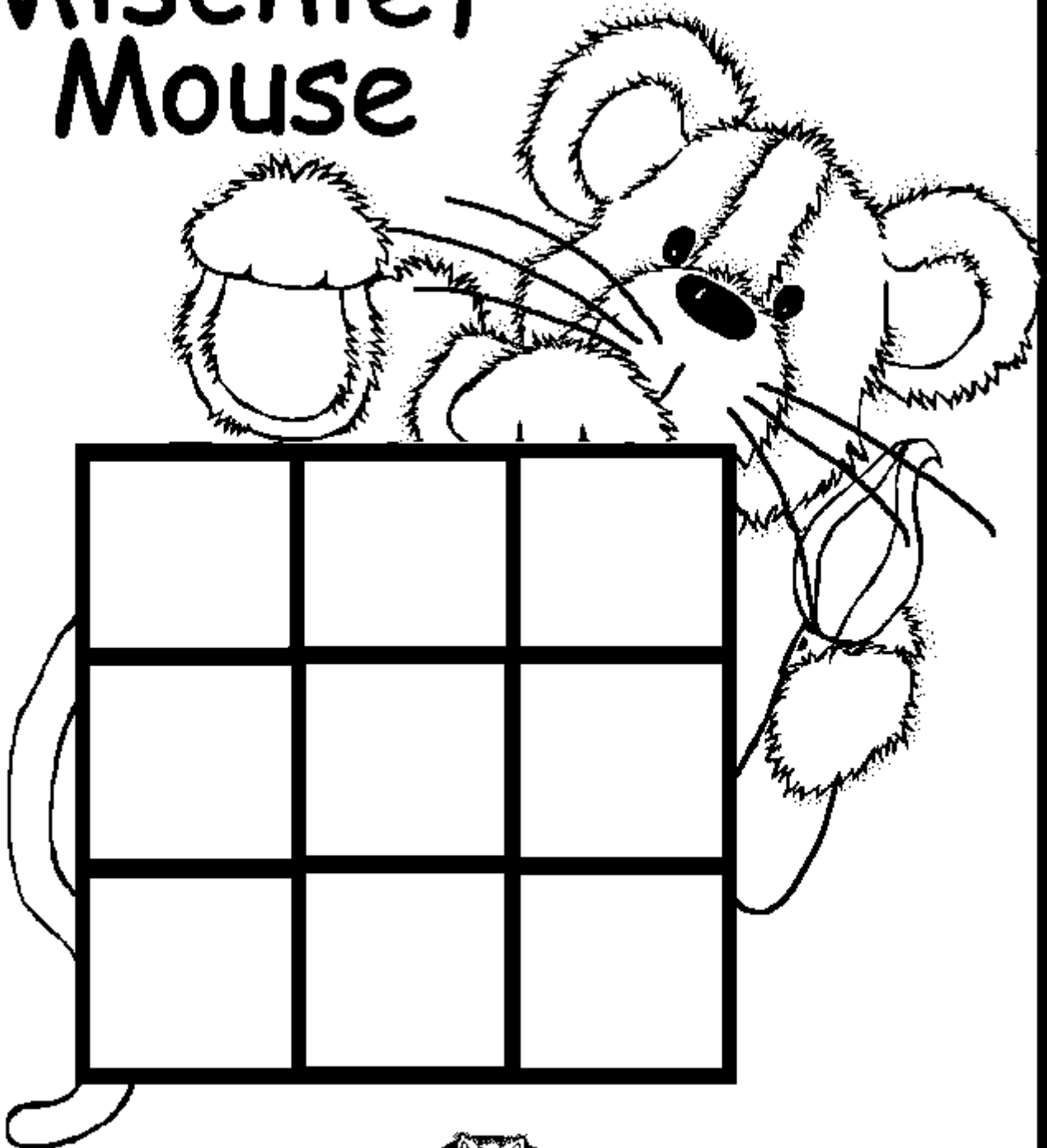
- This game follows the usual basic lotto game rules where the children take turns removing a playing card from the bag and placing it on matching picture that is on their board.

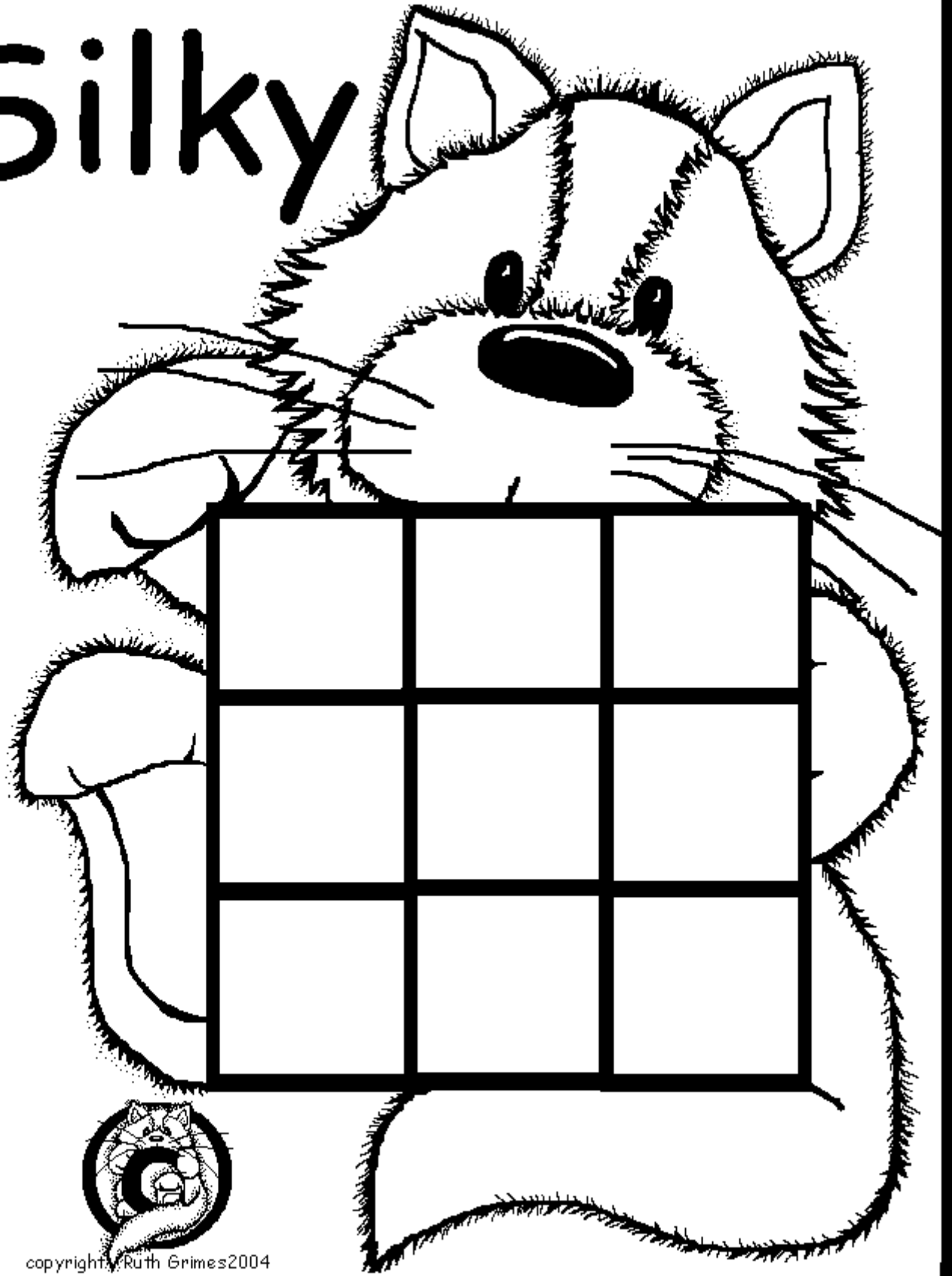

Mischief Mouse



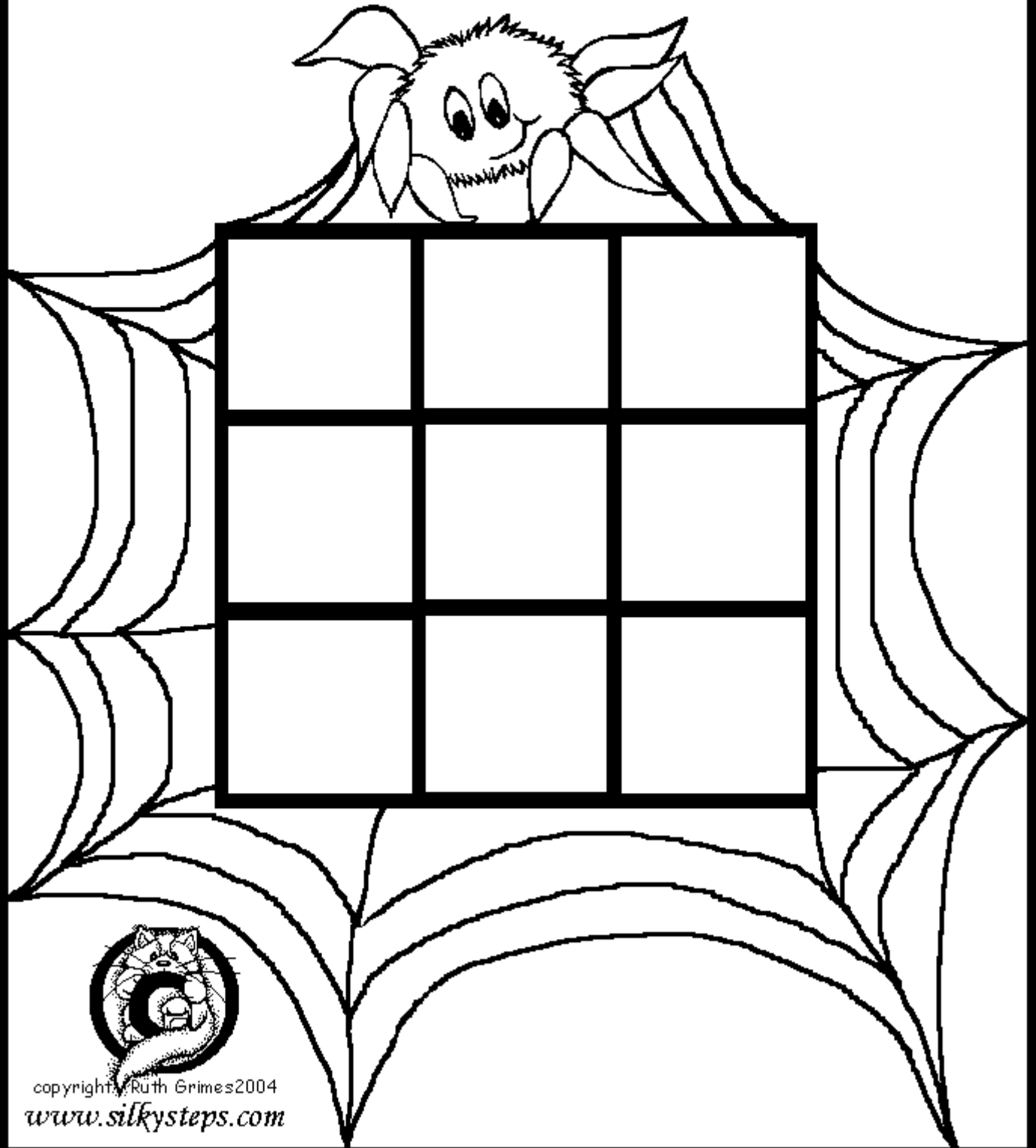
